HOUSE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teams and first practice schedule will be posted on Thursday September 4th, 2009 after 10:00 PM on the IHC website at www.jccdet.org/ihc. ALL HOUSE LEAGUE PLAYERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING THIS INFORMATION! No phone calls regarding schedules or team assignments will be accepted or returned. The honoring of requests for team assignments will be at the sole discretion of the IHC. Requests after the registration deadline of September 1st, 2009, will not be accepted. For all house league players, full payment must accompany the registration form in order to complete registration.
REFUND POLICY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No monetary refunds will be granted under any circumstances. All refunds will be in the form of credits toward a future season. All refund requests must be submitted in writing. Refund requests submitted on or BEFORE Tuesday September 1st, will be subject to a \$25.00 processing fee deducted from the credit. Refund requests submitted on Wednesday September 2nd, & Thursday September 3rd, 2009 will result in a 50% credit. <p>No full or partial credit will be granted, under any circumstances, on or after Friday September 4th, 2009</p>
SPECIAL HOUSE LEAGUE RULES	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> ZERO TOLERANCE - No Fighting- automatic league suspension without refund. The minimum suspension will be 9 consecutive games in which equates to a full season. Fighting is the sole discretion of Referee's & IHC Management. No Checking- only incidental contact will be allowed. Any player receiving 3 minor (2 min.) penalties in one game will receive a game ejection (see #6 under misconduct). A game ejection penalty carries no additional game suspension; however, it does accumulate as a 10-minute misconduct. Any player receiving a 5-minute major penalty will receive an automatic game misconduct. (see #6 under misconduct). The Referee reserves the right to issue a game ejection only for an accidental high-stick; all other majors will be automatic game misconducts. MISCONDUCT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any player receiving a game misconduct will miss the remainder of that game and the next full game scheduled for his team. Any player receiving a third game misconduct during the season will automatically be suspended for the remainder of the season, including playoffs. This suspension will total a minimum of 9 games. Any suspension not served in its entirety during a season will carry over into the next season. Any player receiving a season or indefinite suspension, the IHC reserves the right, at its discretion, to suspend the player for all leagues that player participates in for that season or longer. All appeals or protests of suspensions must be in writing. A non-refundable \$50.00 money order or cashiers check must accompany each appeal or protest. All teams are responsible for the conduct of their spectators. In the event a spectator becomes disruptive during a game, penalties can and will be assessed against the specific spectator's team. GAMES WILL CONSIST OF (3) - 14 MINUTE RUN TIME PERIODS. *Atom Division & Mite Division may be different. During the regular season, tie games will stand. During the playoffs, tie games will be decided by a 5 minute running clock sudden death, and if still tied, a 4 player shoot-out. In the case of a shoot-out only 4 shooters will be allowed to shoot for each team. If it is still tied after the first round, the order of the shooters does not change & they must be the same 4 shooters as in the first round. After the first round the winner is decided by sudden death. Games may start up to 5 minutes prior to scheduled time of game. Each team will be allowed 1- 45-second time-out per period, no carryovers. No time-outs will be allowed during the last two (2) minutes of a game unless the score is within two (2) goals. A (2) minute delay of game penalty will be issued if a time-out is called not meeting these criteria. No refunds will be issued to players suspended or thrown out of any game or league. All players must sign a waiver prior to play. The IHC reserves the right to trade and or move players from team to team, at any time at the IHC's sole discretion in the best interest of the league. Due to the overwhelming amount of requests received for players to be placed on specific teams and the difficulty these certain requests cause in balancing teams, the honoring of requests will be at the sole discretion of the IHC. Mercy Rule- Once a eight-goal differential is reached, the game is over.
