



Summer Inclusion Program Lottery Registration Procedure 2008

The Center Day Camp program supports two types of inclusion. If you are unsure which is best, please call Ann Patronik, Kids All Together Director to discuss your child's needs.

Unaccompanied campers are children with special needs who can participate in the general camp program with little support. The KAT staff will keep an eye on these campers and provide insight to general camp staff on how to best meet their needs.

Accompanied campers are children that need 1:1 support from an inclusion counselor to fully participate in the general camp program. Campers will be placed in the camp program with general campers of the same age.

A limited number of openings are available in each camp program for Accompanied campers. Priority will be given to former campers. Inclusion openings per session are as follows: 4 K'TonTon, 5 Chaverim, 10 Keshet, 10 B'yachad, 7 Treckers, 7 Teen Tour, and 7 Sports/Imagitivity one week sessions.

Process

General camp brochures will be sent to homes in the mail in early January.

Children who are applying as an *Accompanied Camper* must apply through a lottery system and should NOT register on-line.

The Lottery will work as follows:

The *General Applications must be sent* to the Special Needs office and post marked no later than January 31st, 2008. No walk or online applications will be accepted. Applications must include a \$100 deposit for each session.

A committee will hold a lottery on February 7, 2008.

- Applications of former campers will be pulled first according to the camp division.
- Sibling applications will be pulled together.
- Campers will be placed in either or both sessions based on the request and availability.
- Deposits will be processed after enrollment.
- Families applying for a scholarship will be included in the lottery and enrolled in the inclusion program. If a scholarship is not awarded, families may pay the camp fee or withdraw from the program. Someone on the waiting list will fill this spot.
- Campers who do not get into the desired program will be placed on a waiting list and deposits will be returned.
- Families will receive notification of their child's enrollment status by February 9th.
